Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➔ Greet members warmly; use last names of the members discreetly to personalize service.➔ Deliver food promptly and accurately to tables, ensuring proper seat placement.➔ Provide bread and water service upon seating and maintain refills throughout service.➔ Clear and reset tables within 5 minutes of guest departure.➔ Assist servers with pre-bussing, beverage refills, and preparing tables for next courses.➔ Set and restock tables with silverware, glassware, and appropriate tableware.➔ Maintain organized, clean service and kitchen pass areas.➔ Stock server stations with beverages, ice, silverware, napkins, and glassware.➔ Assist in buffet setup/breakdown and make specialty coffee drinks as needed.➔ Perform side work such as polishing glassware, folding napkins, and completing closing duties.➔ Communicate with servers and kitchen staff to ensure smooth service.➔ Drive shuttle/golf carts when assigned (valid driver's license required).➔ Respond promptly to member requests and communicate concerns to management.
